In order to comply with our duty to provide information in accordance with Article 12 et seqq. of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are pleased to inform you on data protection below:

Who is the data controller?

Which of your data will be processed by us? And for what purposes?

Whenever we receive data from you, we will only process it for the purposes for which we have received or collected this data.

Data may only be processed for other purposes if the corresponding legal requirements of Article 6(4) GDPR are fulfilled. We will naturally comply with any duty to provide information according to Article 13(3) GDPR and Article 14(4) GDPR in this case.

What is the legal basis for this?

Legal basis for the processing of personal data is, in principle, Article 6 GDPR unless more specific legal provisions exist. The following possibilities are particularly to be mentioned:

- Consent (point (a) of Article 6(1) GDPR);
- Data processing for performing a contract (point (b) of Article 6(1) GDPR);
- Data processing based on a balancing of interests (point (f) of Article 6(1) GDPR);
- Data processing for complying with a legal obligation (point (c) of Article 6(1) GDPR).

Where personal data is processed on the basis of your consent, you always have the right to withdraw your consent with effect for the future.

Where we process data on the basis of a balancing of interests, you, as data subject, have the right to object to the processing of personal data in consideration of the requirements of Article 21 GDPR.

How long will the data be stored?

We will process the data as long as this is necessary for the respective purpose.

To the extent legal retention periods apply – e.g., under commercial or tax law – the respective personal data will be stored for the duration of the retention period. After expiration of the retention period, we will verify whether further processing is necessary. If there is no necessity anymore, the data will be deleted.

At the end of a calendar year, we generally check the data as to the necessity for further processing. Given the quantity of data, this check is carried out with a view to specific types of data or purposes of processing.

You may naturally demand information about the data stored about you from us at any time (see below) and request the deletion of the data or restriction of processing if there is no longer any necessity for it.

To whom will the data be transferred?

Your personal data will, in principle, only be transferred to third parties if this is necessary for the performance of the contract with you, if the transfer on the basis of a balancing of interests within the meaning of point (f) of Article 6(1) GDPR is permissible, if we are legally obliged to transfer the data, or if you have given your consent.

Where will the data be processed?

Your personal data will be exclusively processed in data centers located in the Federal Republic of Germany.

Your rights as “data subject”

You have the right to request information about your personal data processed by us.

If you do not submit your request in written form, we ask for your understanding that we may then require proof from you that you are the person you claim to be.

You also have a right to erasure or restriction of processing to the legally permissible extent.

You also have a right to object to the processing within the framework of statutory provisions. This also applies to the right to data portability.

Pursuant to Article 21(1) and (2) GDPR, you particularly have a right to object to the processing of your data in connection with direct marketing if the processing is based on a balancing of interests.
